**Review, Discuss & Vote to Join Cape Light Compacts Joint Powers Entity and Appoint the Town's Director to the Cape Light Compact Joint Powers Entity**

Mr. Odell stated that nothing substantial has changed since the Board saw the draft document. The Compact can now borrow money, have offices, etc. It takes the burden off the Towns. Ms. Downey went over the timeline; it takes two towns to form the entity. If Brewster votes this evening, it is the second Town. This process should take approximately 1-2 months. Once a majority of the Towns have signed, the former entity can cease to exist.

Selectman Bingham moved that the Board of Selectmen vote, pursuant to General Laws Chapter 40, section 4A1/2, as follows: to join the Cape Light Compact Joint Powers Entity, to authorize Chairman Dickson to execute the Joint Powers Agreement of the Cape Light Compact and to appoint Colin Odell as the Town's Director and to appoint Michael Embury as the Town alternate director to the Cape Light Compact Joint Powers Entity, and to take any other action necessary or relative thereto, Selectman Foley second. The Board voted **5-Yes, 0-No**.
